Required: Immunization Self-Report Form	Michigan State University requires all entering undergraduate students to complete an Immunization Self-Report. Failure to complete this form may affect your ability to attend MSU. In order to submit the Immunization Self-Report, you will need to have activated your MSU NetID and password. Copies of personal medical or immunization records are not acceptable substitutes for the required Immunization Self-Report. Learn more and access the form: https://www.uphys.msu.edu/student
Consent for Medical Treatment if Under Age 18	Turning 18 after you move to campus? If you are under 18 years of age, you should have a parent or guardian sign the "Consent Form for Medical Treatment of Students Under Age 18". Prescription Medications	Bring enough of your current medication to get you through the first month of school as well as a copy of your prescription. Plan enough time for refills! MSU Pharmacy: https://www.healthteam.msu.edu/pharmacy/ Located in Olin Health Center, the MSU Pharmacy can deliver to residence halls, and assist in the transfer of prescriptions.
Review Health Insurance Requirements	While adequate health insurance is recommended for all MSU students, it is required only for incoming international students, medical students, and veterinary students. Health insurance coverage can be through your family's plan, an individual plan, or enrollment in the university-sponsored student health insurance plan which is open to all MSU students https://hr.msu.edu/benefits/students/
Health Summary	For students with a chronic illness bringing a health care summary from your current health care provider can make your transition to Student Health Services much easier. The summary should include the student name, birthdate and student's APID.
