3 PREPAID VISITS & HEALTH INSURANCE

- The first three medical office visits of each school year are prepaid for students registered for MSU classes (excluding Law students). Use your three visits at Olin and/or any of the neighborhood clinics.
- The prepaid visit does not include lab, X-ray, medical procedures, etc.
- For the fourth and subsequent visits (and for lab, etc.) MSU will bill insurance and/or the patient for any costs not paid by insurance.
- Ask your insurance company what will and won't be covered while you are away at school.

PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

- Olin Health Center backs up to Grand River Avenue next to the Grand River parking ramp. Patients can park on the lower two levels of the ramp. Parking requires payment by license plate number.
- Parking stubs from the East Lansing parking structure behind SBS can be validated at the clinic in which the patient is treated.
- **CATA bus service** stops in front of Olin on E. Circle Drive and behind on Grand River Avenue.
- The **Courtesy Van** provides free transport to and from Olin Health Center for those too ill to take the CATA bus (within one mile of campus). Call **517-353-4700**.
