<p><b>Required:</b> Immunization Self-Report Form</p> 	<p><b>Michigan State University requires all entering undergraduate students to complete an Immunization Self-Report.</b> Failure to complete this form may affect your ability to attend MSU. In order to submit the Immunization Self-Report, you will need to have <a href="#">activated your MSU NetID</a> and password.</p> <p>Copies of personal medical or immunization records are not acceptable substitutes for the required Immunization Self-Report.</p> <p>Learn more and access the form: <a href="https://www.uphys.msu.edu/student">https://www.uphys.msu.edu/student</a></p>
<p>Consent for Medical Treatment if Under Age 18</p> 	<p><b>Turning 18 after you move to campus?</b> If you are under 18 years of age, you should have a parent or guardian sign the "Consent Form for Medical Treatment of Students Under Age 18". <p>Prescription Medications</p> 	<p>Bring enough of your current medication to get you through the first month of school as well as a copy of your prescription. <p>Health Summary</p> 	<p>For students with a chronic illness bringing a health care summary from your current health care provider can make your transition to Student Health Services much easier.</p> <p>The summary should include the student name, birthdate and student's APID.</p>
