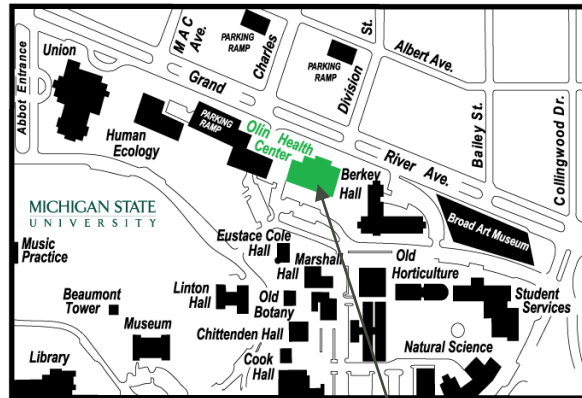

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE SICK AND NEED CARE . . .

Call 517.353.4660 to make an appointment. Bring your MSU student ID and, if you wish to have services billed to insurance, bring your insurance card with you.



After Hours Care—Health-related questions can be answered any time day or night, call the 24 hour Phone Information Nurse at 517.353.5557. The nurse can also assist with facilitating transportation by cab if medical care is needed. Learn more at olin.msu.edu.

3 PREPAID VISITS

- The first three medical office visits of each school year are prepaid for students registered for MSU classes (excluding Lifelong Ed and Law students). Use your three visits at Olin, and/or any of the neighborhood clinics!
- At **CAPS**, there is no charge for the first three lifetime Psychiatry visits or for short-term Counseling services.
- The prepaid visit does not include lab, medical procedures, X-ray, etc.
- For the fourth and subsequent visits (and for lab, etc.) MSU will bill insurance and/or the patient for any costs not paid by insurance.
- Ask **your insurance company** what will and won't be covered while you are away at school in East Lansing.

COUNSELING & PSYCHIATRIC SERVICES

CAPS combines the clinical services of the MSU Counseling Center and Olin Psychiatry Clinic under one roof, providing improved access for students. CAPS puts students first, welcoming every student and taking into account all aspects of a student's identity, such as race, ethnicity, culture, religion, language, gender, and sexual orientation. Pharmacy & Delivery Service—Request refills and free delivery online or by phone 24/7. Call 517.353.9165.

Laboratory, Physical Therapy & Radiology—Lab, radiology and physical therapy orders are acceptable from a student's established provider from home or a provider from MSU or the surrounding area. Test results / progress reports will be faxed to the ordering physician.

Phone Information Nurse (24/7)—Registered nurses can assist with medical decision-making and health-related questions. Call 517.353.5557.

State of Relaxation—Massage, Reiki & reflexology by appointment. Call 517.353.4660.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES & INFO

Health Promotion—Nutrition Counseling, **SPARTANfit** Exercise Programs, Center for Sexual Health Promotion (including HIV testing), ATOD (alcohol, tobacco & other drug) education, individual counseling, and group education programs. Most Health Promotion services are available at no charge and do not count toward the three prepaid visits.

Parking at Olin—Olin Health Center is at 463 East Circle Drive, backing up to Grand River Avenue. The Grand River Parking ramp is next to Olin. Patients can park on the lower two levels of the ramp. Parking requires payment by license plate number.

Parking stubs from the East Lansing Albert Street parking structure (habitrail) can be validated within Olin at the clinic in which the patient is treated.
